THAR 4720 – Global Theories of Performance (Forms of Drama)

Aiming to expand horizons beyond the West, this class examines key theoretical questions and debates from modern and contemporary Southern Africa, North Africa, the Middle East, Oceania, Latin America, East Asia, the Caribbean, and India. The course also incorporates readings in dramatic literature to present these theories in their respective historical, cultural, and theatrical contexts. Issues in postcolonialism, aesthetics, globalization, and interculturalism are also explored in this class in search of a genuinely global understanding of theatre and performance.

THAR 4710 - History of Acting Theory (Seminar in Theatre History and Drama)

This seminar investigates the development of ideas concerning acting from Africa, Asia, the Americas, and Europe, spanning from antiquity to the present day. Students work towards developing a systematic understanding of the concepts and issues that informed ideas of what acting is, has been, or should be.

Practical experience as a dramaturg on School of Theater productions, including historical, textual, and biographical research, as well as audience outreach activities.
